Shoothouse and Advanced Handgun Techniques

OVERVIEW: This 16-hour course is designed to be physically and mentally challenging. Officers will encounter numerous high stress multiple engagements, running tactical handgun courses, live-fire shoothouse exercises, and a reactive tactical shooting course geared towards positive and acceptable solutions. The applicant should be aware that they will be required to complete all courses of fire with an 80% score to successfully complete a qualification course and written exam.

ATTIRE: Appropriate attire required pursuant to Chapter 11. **No shorts or tank tops allowed.**

EQUIPMENT: It is the responsibility of the individual officer to bring his own, duty gear, i.e., duty belt, holster, re-load capability, handgun, handcuffs, body armor, gas mask and flashlight.

ENROLLMENT: The course is open to all sworn personnel. Training Course Application (MPI-24) must be submitted through the concerned officer's chain-of-command to the Training Bureau. Outside Agencies must mail a registration letter to Major Bernie Gonzalez signed by an authorized agency administrator (Commander or above), requesting their sworn personnel attend the course. Positions are given on a "first come, first serve" basis, and they will be confirmed by the course coordinator. **All training requests must be received and confirmed by Friday, March 7, 2008, in order to ensure a position in the class.**

INCENTIVES: 16-hours of mandatory retraining.
