## TACTICAL HANDGUN WORKSHOP

**DATES:** September 24-25, 2008

**OVERVIEW:** This 16-hour course is designed to be physically and mentally challenging. Officers will learn how to enhance their marksmanship capabilities during high stress situations. Emphasis will be placed on one handed shooting, shooting on the move, and engaging moving targets while seeking cover/concealment. The applicant should be aware that they will be required to complete all courses of fire with an 80% score to successfully complete a qualification course and written exam.

**ATTIRE:** Appropriate attire required pursuant to Chapter 11. **No shorts or tank tops allowed.**

**EQUIPMENT:** It is the responsibility of the individual officer to bring his own, duty gear, i.e., duty belt, holster, re-load capability, handgun, handcuffs, body armor, gas mask and flashlight.

**ENROLLMENT:** The course is open to all sworn personnel. Training Course Application (MPI-24) must be submitted through the concerned officer's chain-of-command to the Training Bureau. Outside Agencies must mail a registration letter to Major Bernie Gonzalez signed by an authorized agency administrator (Commander or above), requesting their sworn personnel attend the course. Positions are given on a "first come, first serve" basis, and they will be confirmed by the course coordinator. **All training requests must be received and confirmed by Friday, September 12, 2008, in order to ensure a position in the class.**

**INCENTIVES:** 16-hours of mandatory retraining.
